# EXPLORE THE BEST OF THE LAST FRONTIER

#### KETCHIKAN

This rustic town is widely regarded as one of the prettiest along the Inside Passage. Surrounded by the Tongass Forest and overlooked by Deer Mountain, Ketchikan is famous for its abundant salmon, impressive collection of authentic totem poles, and colorful houses along Creek Street — a stilted boardwalk and historical landmark. Sea kayaking, mountain hikes, and float plane rides over Misty Fjords are standout activities.

#### 2 SITKA

Accessible by air or sea only, Sitka is a cultural jewel perched along the Inside Passage. Located on the 100-mile-long Baranof Island, the town is surrounded by the Tongass Forest, mountains, and water. Outdoor activities abound, from kayaking to fly fishing, but it's the area's rich Tlingit cultural heritage that makes this such a unique destination.

#### **ICY STRAIT POINT**

Located on Chichagof Island, the area is famous for having more bears than people — and Spasski River is the place to see them. Visit a restored turn-of-the-century salmon cannery. For those looking to catch a glimpse of humpback whales or brown bears, a sea kayak outing could deliver both. For pure adrenaline, the world's largest ZipRider zipline is an action-packed excursion.

#### JUNEAU

This compact capital bustles with activity, with floatplanes buzzing over the water, hikers setting out for forest trails, and visitors browsing the shops of the downtown area. Nature is never far away in Juneau, with bald eagles perching in trees around town. The waters of Auke Bay are rich feeding grounds for marine mammals, from humpback whales to orcas. Nearby, Mendenhall Glacier is a worthy diversion, offering wildlife encounters to go with the icy spectacle.

#### 5 SKAGWAY

This charming town is surrounded by extraordinary natural beauty, from towering mountains to tumbling waterfalls. Outdoor activities abound, including ziplining, white water rafting, hiking, and summer dog sledding. In town, restaurants offer fresh Alaskan fare, and an eclectic collection of galleries and boutiques are perfect for souvenir shopping. For a taste of Skagway's Gold Rush history, the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad travels the famous Chilkoot Trail.

#### SEWARD

On the shores of Resurrection Bay, this history-rich port town is nestled against the glacier-covered Kenai Mountains, and offers access to inspiring landscapes, incredible marine life, and massive glaciers. And, as the gateway to the Kenai Fjords National Park, the Harding Icefield—an expanse of ice and snow created over 23,000 years ago — is easily within reach, and culminates in 40 glaciers that dramatically calve into the sea.

#### **HOMER**

Known as the halibut fishing capital of the world, this picture-perfect hamlet is the access point to Kachemak Bay State Park, Alaska's first state park, and offers approximately 400,000 acres of forests, glaciers, and mountains to explore. Stroll the Spit, a natural causeway extending into Kachemak Bay, and look for eagles soaring overhead. Join a fishing trip or watch for whales, porpoise, and seals during the ferry ride to the town of Halibut Cove.

#### ALYESKA (GIRDWOOD)

Tucked in a luxuriant glacier-carved valley, encircled by the Chugach Mountains and bordering a temperate rainforest, Girdwood is a playground for wilderness adventure. For a special day, take a gondola ride to the top of Mount Alyeska or hike up for panoramic views and hanging glaciers.

#### ANCHORAGE

A cosmopolitan city perched on the edge of the wilderness, Anchorage blends city excitement and the great outdoors. Take a stroll along Tony Knowles Coastal Trail for stunning views of Anchorage's skyline and the Cook Inlet. Or take a once-in-a-lifetime excursion to Katmai National Park for incredible bear viewing.

#### **1** TALKEETNA

Talkeetna is a unique, eclectic community set amid incomparable scenic beauty. When the skies are clear, panoramic vistas of Denali and other snow-covered mountains of the Alaska Range are revealed from all over town. The village's unique location provides access to every imaginable way to experience the magnificence of "The Great One" — from seasoned bush pilots taking you up into the skies and over the awe-inspiring north face to leisurely hikes on quiet trails and river rafting down the glacier-fed Talkeetna River.

#### 1 DENALI NATIONAL PARK

One of Earth's last frontiers. Denali National Park is home to abundant wildlife and magnificent vistas within its six million acres of pristine wilderness, with the centerpiece being North America's highest peak. And while designated wilderness is highly protected, Denali offers a range of activities. Flight sightseeing planes soar over the mountains for breathtaking views, while rafting on the Nenana River can be a gentle float or a thrilling white-water ride.

#### 12 FAIRBANKS

Alaska's second largest (and most remote) city is only 200 miles south of the Arctic Circle. Pan for gold in one of the many creeks that still turn up flakes, or admire the native art treasures on display at the Museum of the North. For the best opportunity to see the Northern Lights dance across the night sky, travel on a late season Cruisetour that ends in Fairbanks.

#### VICTORIA

Located on British Columbia's Vancouver Island, Victoria is known as "The Garden City" for its greenery, lushness, and beauty. Head to world-famous Butchart Gardens for some of the most stunning landscapes anywhere, or Beacon Hill Park for a relaxing stroll surrounded by nature. For a slice of history, visit the expertly maintained 19th-century Craigdarroch Castle, and Parliament Buildings.

#### **PRINCE RUPERT**

A coastal gem nestled on Kaien Island near the Alaskan panhandle, Prince Rupert is the gateway to British Columbia's wild north. Surrounded by the Great Bear Rainforest, it offers world-class fishing, whale watching, and exciting wildlife encounters. Stroll the waterfront, explore Indigenous heritage sites, or savor fresh seafood.
